Medicare.Gov & State of Mississippi Positive Rankings

From the Medicare.gov website, which compares nursing homes to others across the country, **Leakesville Rehabilitation and Nursing Center** received the following rankings:

No complaints of moderate to severe pain were self-reported among short stay and long term residents.

No new or worse pressure ulcers. Cases of high-risk pressure ulcers were 3.4 percent (3.4%), five percentage points below the state average.

No use of physical restraints.

Fewer cases of urinary tract infections (UTI) than the state average.

Less use of antipsychotic medicine in short term patients than the state average.

Residents more independent and needing less help with activities of daily living (ADL) than the state average.

Above the state average in doing flu vaccinations - both for influenza and pneumococcal.

Success in weight control and monitoring depression symptoms.
